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BEFORE THE REHEARSAL

- ☐ Confirm rehearsal date, time, and ceremony location with wedding party
 - ☐ Share rehearsal schedule and arrival instructions
 - ☐ Confirm officiant availability
 - ☐ Finalize ceremony order and participants
 - ☐ Prepare printed ceremony outline (optional)
 - ☐ Confirm music cues with DJ or musicians
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AFTER THE REHEARSAL

- ☐ Confirm rehearsal dinner location and arrival time
 - ☐ Remind wedding party of next day arrival time
 - ☐ Answer final ceremony questions
 - ☐ Distribute any gifts or important items
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DURING THE REHEARSAL

- ☐ Practice processional order (parents, wedding party, flower girl, ring bearer)
 - ☐ Confirm where each person stands during the ceremony
 - ☐ Walk through key ceremony moments (vows, rings, readings)
 - ☐ Test microphone placement if available
 - ☐ Practice recessional exit order
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
